2025 Into the Light 5K Walk/Run

WHAT: Into the Light 5K Walk/Run

WHEN: September 20, 2025

WHERE: Marksville Courthouse square

TIME: CHECK-IN 8:00-9:00 a.m. in front of the Marksville Courthouse. COMMENCEMENT begins at 9:00 a.m. on the courthouse steps. WALK/RUN begins immediately following commencement.

THINGS TO DO **BEFORE EVENT DAY** (OPTIONAL- NOT REQUIRED):

- Register to Run/Compete (there is a runner registration tab).
- Add a team If you would like to participate as a team (eg. In honor of a loved one who died by suicide, representing an organization/school/etc., in support of someone who struggles, etc.): you can create a team by entering the team name on our website there is an "Add a Team" tab read more information about forming a team under that tab.
- Donate to an existing Team on the 5K home page.
- Become a sponsor- there is a sponsor tab on the home page. As a thank-you, you will be included on our sponsor banner, website, email blasts, and event shirt (depending on sponsor-level). See sponsor form for more details.
- Get a picture If you have lost a loved one to suicide, bring a picture to hang on our memorial board (please put your contact information on the back of the photo in case you forget to bring it home after the event).
- Preorder event shirt(s) there is a tab on the 5K page.
- Become Vendor If you are a mental health resource, agency that has any kind of service to provide, person or business that has anything to sell, etc. and you would like to share it at our event, please fill out a vendor form found on the 5K page instructions included. If you are not pre-registered to have a booth, you are still welcome but it is better to pre-register.
- Donate items for our silent auction.

THINGS TO DO ON EVENT DAY 8:00-9:00:

1. Bead boards (there will be 2): choose your color bead. (Why do you support the cause)? There will be someone there to help you. (This is free and everyone needs to wear a bead)

SILVER - struggling personally BLUE - support the cause RED - lost a 1st responder/military WHITE - lost a relative or friend GREEN - lost a spouse or partner PURPLE- lost a sibling GOLD - a loved one is struggling TEAL - lost a child PINK - lost a parent

2. Vendor booths – Please visit the vendor booths and learn about resources available. Sometimes the deterrent for reaching out for help is not knowing what resources are available to you. As an incentive, you will

receive a vendor card at the beadboard. If you would like a chance to win \$50 cash, please visit each booth to learn about their resources. Each booth will sign your card (instructions will be on your card).

- 3. Runners: Report to the SaveCenla tent: If you have preregistered, you will receive a packet that includes your runner's shirt, your name tag, and instructions. You can also register the day of (\$30), but you will not receive a runner's shirt that day we will mail your shirt to you. There are 3 categories for both men and women (under 14, 14-18, and 19 and up). 1st-3rd place winners in each category will be awarded a metal.
- 4. Pre-ordered event shirts: pick these up at the SaveCenla tent. There will be limited event shirts for sale (\$30) that day, and we cannot guarantee your size. You can also place an order for a shirt, and we will mail it to you when it comes in.
- 5. Memorial list: If you have lost a loved one to suicide, please find this list at the SaveCenla tent opposite the SaveCenla tent with tickets, etc. Put your loved one's name on this list. You will receive one free ticket for a butterfly that will be given after the run, for the butterfly launch/memorial more butterflies may be purchased at the same place.
- 6. Food tickets: There will be jambalaya (\$6), colas and gator aid (\$2), cotton candy (\$1), popcorn (\$1), water (free) You will need tickets to purchase these things. Tickets can be purchased at the SaveCenla tent.
- 7. Team donations: If you would like to donate to a particular team, please do so at the SaveCenla tent. (the team that receives the largest donation will be recognized the day of the event, in the local paper, on our website, and our 2025-2026 sponsor banner.
- 8. Donate: you may donate on our website (paypal, venmo, or cash app SaveCenla) or at the SaveCenla tent.
- 9. Sponsors: Our 2025-2026 sponsors will be listed on the sponsor banner, but if you did not have an opportunity to become a 2025-2026 sponsor before the banner was printed, it is not too late. Sponsor forms can be found at the SaveCenla tent. We will save room to add last-minute company logos.
- 10. Memory board: Hang the picture of your loved one who died by suicide.
- 11. Story board: Write a heartfelt note.
- 12. Prayer net: Pray a silent prayer and tie a ribbon to represent that prayer.
- 13. Team Photos: each team sign in at the team photo booth and have your team photo taken. You will have the option to purchase photos that day. If your team is not already included on our website, it will be added the next week after the walk.
- 14. Veteran Boots: 17 veterans lose their lives to suicide every single day. If you are a veteran, actively serving, know someone who has served, or want to represent a soldier who has lost his/her life to suicide, and would like to carry a pair of military boots on the 5K to honor a soldier, please go to the line of military boots where someone will help distribute the boots (first come, first serve). You will need to sign your name, take a group picture, and return the boots as you return from the 5K.
- 15. Silent auction: Check out the items for auction and place a bid.
- 16. Turn in your vendor incentives under the SaveCenla tent there will be a sign.

RECAP: WHAT WILL YOU FIND UNDER THE SAVECENLA TENTS:

 - a. Runner registration (pre-registered and register the day of).
 - b. preordered event shirts there will be a few for sale but no guarantee that they will have your size (preordered price \$25; day of price \$30, and order at the 5K price \$30).
 - c. tickets for jambalaya \$6, cottoncandy \$1, popcorn \$1, drinks \$2, water free
 - d. sponsor forms
 - e. Donate to a team or just donate

 - a. Memorial list and butterflies

b. Vendor incentive turn-in to win \$50 cash

ORDER OF EVENTS:

- 1. 8:00-9:00: Registration (beads, runner check-in, memorial list/butterflies, food tickets, vendor booths, memory board, story board, prayer net, sponsor/donate, team photos, pick up combat boots, listen to music, and visit)
- 2. 9:00: opening prayer, VFW flag raising, national anthem, speakers, runners begin, walkers begin. NOTE: Runners who place will be awarded medals as they cross the finish line and then a group picture and winner announcements as soon as the last winner crosses the finish line.
- 3. Butterflies will be handed out as the walkers/runners return from the 5K they must have a ticket. We will announce if there are butterflies left to purchase.
- 4. The winners of the vendor incentive, silent auctions will be announced payments will be done at the SaveCenla tent.
- 5. Announce the Team winner and trophy
- 6. Butterfly release/memorial
- 7. Conclusion of Event
